Schools prepare for first day

All five area schools will be back in session shortly, with Creighton Community School opening its doors first later this week. Sept. 1 is the first day of class in Creighton, with classes for the Flin Flon schools -Hapnot Collegiate, Many Faces Education Centre, Ecole McIsaac School and Ruth Betts Community School - starting Sept. 7.

The first day in Creighton

With Flin Flon schools starting next week, there will be few changes from a standard school year. With no current COVID-19related restrictions or health orders in place for Manitoba in 2019 and earlier than the past two years.

"They [safety protocols] are still planned in case they're needed, but they're not in place."
