ike millions around the world, Michele Rowe and Dick Kennedy were horrified by Russia's invasion of Ukraine. The sight of families fleeing death and destruction was deeply distressing.

It made them reflect on the plight of refugees around the world, and ask: Could Maple Creek provide safe haven for a displaced family? Perhaps even two families?

From such reflection, a group was born ... the Maple Creek Refugee Sponsorship Committee (MCRSC), which already has a Facebook presence.

Although Rev. Rowe is pastor of the Maple Creek United Church and Father Dick is an Anglican Church member, MCRSC is a community group (a Non-governmental organization), not a church one.
